BUILDING COMMITTEE

HALL RENTAL

Rental charge for hall to Red Cross will increase a small amount; beginning June 1. It has not been increased for several years, during which our building costs have increased substantially.

BINGO

Carl Bergquist reported a person has asked us to increase prize amounts on portions of Progressive and Winner Take All games. During discussion it was agreed such changes would require restructuring paperwork and calling of games. Prizes will not be changed.

FISH FRY

Sales of all dinners totaled \$11,000. Costs are expected to exceed \$6,000. All sections ran smoothly and adjusted quickly to changing procedures. Although starting with only drive thru dinners, inside dining was included in last two dinners. Several people asked for future inside dining. If held again, its planning, preparation and operations must be reviewed.
