COMMITTEE REPORTS:

BUILDING COMMITTEE

Vinny Ruiz has obtained an estimate for replacement of Council Room carpet - \$11,000.

He recommended its consideration due to carpet's current poor condition. The room is currently empty, which cannot continue since it is dedicated to its use by the Council. It must be prepared for our activities. Access to the carpet for its replacement will then be difficult. Costs for new carpet will increase substantially in 2021.

Officers and Trustees at meeting recommended improvement of the main hall be given priority.

George Asmus reported an estimate of replacing carpet in main hall is \$14,000.

George has contacted several people for an estimate of replacing ceiling. The presence of insulation caused some to refuse doing it. He received an estimated cost of \$4,300 for ceiling tiles. Several methods of removal/installation were discussed. It was explained that several wires go across the ceiling.

Agreement was reached that replacement of ceiling tile takes precedence over other improvements needed here.
